













# **ORGANISING AUTHORITY**

# IV. Mandarin Cup will be organized by Bodrum Municipality Bodrum Sailing Club between 3-7 January 2025 in Bodrum Türkiye.

#### 1) RULES

- 1.1) The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing (2025- 2028). The Regatta shall be open to competitors of all nationalities within the limits of World Sailing statement concerning the situation in Ukraine 1st of March 2022.
- 1.2) The first three sentences of RRS 61.1(a) are changed to 'The protesting boat shall inform the other boat at the first reasonable opportunity. When her protest will concern an incident in the racing area she shall hail 'Protest'. She shall inform the Race Committee at the finishing line immediately after finishing of the boat/s being protested, or as soon as practicable after she retires.'
- 1.3) RRS 40 and the preamble to Part 4 are changed as follows:
  - 1.3.1) The first sentence of RRS 40.1 is deleted and replaced by: "Each competitor shall wear a personal flotation device (PFD) according to class rule 4.2 (a), properly secured at all times while on the water except when temporarily adding or removing clothing."
  - 1.3.2) Add to the preamble of Part 4, after 'racing': "...except rule 40.1 as amended by Sailing Instruction 1.3.1"
- 1.4) Rule changes will appear in full in the sailing instructions. The sailing instructions may also change other racing rules.
- 1.5) If there is a conflict between languages the English text will take precedence.
- 1.6) In all rules governing this championship, both "athlete" and "competitor" mean a person competing in the event. The term "support person" means a person as defined in RRS
  - [SP] denotes a rule for which a standard penalty may be applied by the Race Committee without a hearing or a discretionary penalty applied by the International Jury with a hearing. This changes RRS A5 and 63.1, and
  - [NP] denotes a rule that shall not be grounds for protests by a boat. This changes RRS 60.1 (a).
- 1.7) English is the Official Language of the Championship. If there is a conflict between languages the language of the original version of the relevant document will take precedence

#### 2 ADVERTISING

2.1) Boats may be required to display advertising chosen and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

#### 3 ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

- 3.1) The Cup is open to Optimist, Techno293 and İQ Foils classes. The regatta is open to all nations (Except Russian and Belarussian).

- 3.3) Deadline for the entries is 15 December 2023.
- 3.4) Final registrations at the venue shall be made latest on Thursday, 3rd January 2025 at 18.00 by the Race Secretary. Those who have their visa for licence in 2024 will be able to participate in the race (for Turkish Sailors).
- 3.5) Entry fee is 50 Euros.

# 4 FORMAT OF THE REGATTA OPTIMIST

- 4.1) According to number of participant in the regatta Optimist Senior (born in 2010 2013), Optimist Junior (born 2014 and 2015) and Optimist Bambinos (born 2016 and later) will start together. However, taking into account the number of participants, the organizing committee may decide follows; categories (optimist senior, optimist junior and optimist bambinos) will be able to compete on separate courses. This will be announced to the sailors, coaches and clubs immediately after the pre-registration is completed (after December 15, 2024). Optimist Juniors and Optimist Bambinos will be awarded separately as stated in the Notice of Race (NoR 16).
- 4.2) The initial allocation to divisions will be done by the Race Committee on January 3rd with the list of competitors already registered by the time of the allocation. Competitors registering later will be added at the bottom of the sorted list in the order of registration. The fleet will be divided into divisions if the participants more than 80, as far as possible with the same number of boats.
- 4.3) All details about the format of the regatta will be determined on Sailing Instruction.

#### **TECHNO 293**

- 4.4) The Techno 293 (T293 ) Class Rules will apply, with exceptions as published on the official notice board. RRS Appendix B will apply.
- 4.5) The participating classes and divisions shall be: Techno 293 (T293) Junior Boy & Girl; Youth Boy & Girl; U13
- 4.6) Age Divisions:
  - **T293 Junior** shall be under 15 years of age (born in or after 2011, but not later than 2015). **T293 Youth** shall be under 17 years of age (born in or after 2009 but not later than 2013).
  - **T293 U13** shall be under 13 years of age (born in or after 2013, but not later than 2015). Additional prizes will be awarded to the first three T293 U13 boys and girls, who register the 5.0 sail only.
- 4.7) A minimum of 3 competitors is required to constitute a division.

#### **IQ FOIL**

- 4.8) IQ Foil Class Rules will apply, with exceptions as published on the official notice board. RRS Appendix B will apply.
- 4.9) The participating classes and divisions shall be:
  - IQ Foil U23 age division shall be open to all competitors entered in the Mandarin Cup but only if that competitor is under 23 years of age on 31 December 2025 (born on 2003 or later). IQ Foil Youth ( U19 ) shall be under 19 years of age ( born in or after 2007 )
  - Tarton Touch ( 013 / Shan be under 13 /ears of age ( both in of an

IQ Foil Junior;

- (U17) shall be under 17 years of age (born in or after 2009)
- (U15) shall be under 15 years of age (born in or after 2011)
- 4.10) A minimum of 3 competitors required for each event to constitute a valid series.







4.11) In case the number of participants in the IQ Foil Classes is 24 or more, the Race Committee will be able to make grouping in the Slalom Course application and in this case, it will plan and announce the races with the groups it will announce.

6.1) All competitors shall comply with the Class Rules. Boats may be checked at any time on shore and on the water.

7.1) The sailing instructions will be made available upon registration at the venue and official website (<a href="http://www.bodrumsporyelken.org/en/mandarin-cup">http://www.bodrumsporyelken.org/en/mandarin-cup</a>).







#### 8 VENUE

8.1) The Championship will be held in the city of Bodrum-Mugla. The shore venue will be B.B. Bodrum Sailing Club and the racing area will be in front of the venue.

#### 9 THE COURSE

9.1) The course is shown in Sailing Instructions.

#### 10 PENALTY SYSTEM

10.1) Appendix P will apply.

#### 11 SCORING

#### **For Optimist Class**

- 11.1) Low-point system of RRS App A will be applied.
- 11.2) 3 races are required to be completed to constitute a series.
- 11.3) When from 1 to 3 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race score.
- 11.4) When from 4 and more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

#### For T293 Class

11.5) Scoring will be according to the WCR Appendix A as amended by Appendix B. Scoring for group racing will be specified in the sailing instructions.

#### For IQ Class

11.6) In IQ Foil Classes, the Slalom Course (for each Heat when competing as a Single Fleet) will receive one series race point. When the Fleet or Group is divided into more than one Heat, the following table will be used for scoring.
